Each Mother's Day we offer the opportunity for families with newborns to participate in a time of thanking God for the gift of life as they seek wisdom and support from their church family in being the parents God desires.

Graduate Recognition

God wants to be a part of every stage of our life. Whether it is High School or College we like to recognize students accomplishments and pray with them as they take their next step in the journey of life.



This annual 3 day experience is offered FREE of charge each summer for rising 3rd-6th graders. Local coaches volunteer to give instruction in sports such as basketball, baseball/softball, volleyball, soccer and tennis. Students learn developmental skills, character building concepts and team work. We have inspirational messages from a sports figure (such as high school or college athlete or coach) each day. Lunch and snacks are provided and each camper receives a special gift to remember their camp experience.



Members of Woodland as well as the community donate to our benevolence fund which is used to assist Nelson residents in crisis. We help families with utility bills, rent, groceries and other needs so they can get back on their feet.
